The teams should respect all custom formalities currently in force in Kazakhstan when crossing the border points.

The participants should fill in special customs forms in which are given the responsibilities of all tourists entering Kazakhstan.

The Equestrian Federation of Kazakhstan and the OC will contact their national customs and veterinary authorities in order to facilitate the movement of the horses accompanied by FEI - passports and necessary Veterinary Certificate at Frontier - Crossing - Points into and out of this country.

The A.T.A Carnet is indispensable to cross the border. The OC will not act as financial guarantor versus the Custom Authorities in cases where team import horses into Kazakhstan without A.T.A. Carnets. For all riders from member countries of the CIS TF No 1 must be presented National Health Certificate.

# THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

## FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1.** At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 2.** Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3.** Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 4.** Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
- 5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**

One Team per country permitted to participate.

The competition will take place over two rounds with teams comprising 3 - 4 competitors in the 1<sup>st</sup> round, each riding a single horse throughout the competition. In the event of equality of penalties in the two rounds for the 1<sup>st</sup> place there will be a jump-off, between one rider per team.

A maximum of 8 teams will participate in the second round with 3 riders per team. The home team if not qualified for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round among the 8 qualified teams, has the right to take part in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round providing its score does not exceeding that of the last qualified team by more than 8 penalties.

Each Team consists of a Maximum of 3 riders in the second round.

There will be a Jump - off for the 1st place in case of a tie on penalties following the 2nd round.

Starting order: according to Art 264.6 Horses participating in this competition are not entitled to enter competition No. 3.
